Pastoral Update | Father Mike

Father Mike updated council that the ACA is at 70.23% of the parish goal and moving right along. The Megomoolamania and the Annual Fund is also moving along well. The St. Anthony’s group is hosting for the parish a Mud Hens night. The Choir will be singing the National Anthem. Father Mike introduced a one-page prospectus to Council that he will be meeting with Bishop Thomas to discuss. Council is to prepare questions and comments and email them to Father Mike. The Fish Fry information will be in the bulletin soon. School enrollment is now at 240. This is a healthy increase. Father Mike discussed Father Kidd coming to live at the Rectory while being assigned at Central Catholic and St. Joseph, downtown. John Morrissey asked if the parish will be receiving income since Father Kidd will be residing at the Rectory. Father Mike stated that the parish will receive compensation for costs for both rent and food.

The reports were reviewed. Operating cash is as expected. All invoices are paid up to date. Net Income YTD in rising. Garden Group now has an account on the Balance sheet. This was a donation to the Garden Group. This was one item listed by the audit performed by the Diocese of Toledo. Some accounts must be listed on the Balance Sheet. The Garden Group is the first one of those groups. FACTS is not collecting as expected on past due tuition accounts for MBSP. Koziarski has begun collecting on past due accounts by making calls, holding grade cards, and diplomas. So far, this effort has been successful and Koziarski will continue to contact families to make arrangements. John Morrissey asked how to proceed with past due campaign pledges. Heather and Father Mike will be looking at pledges that have not been paid.
