General Summary: The After Care Worker works with parish and school staff to supervise children after school hours during the school year. Works with the Operations Manager. supervisor.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities:

- Watch the children along with other After Care workers and volunteers.
- Provides snacks to the children.
- Supervise children while playing and studying. Make sure they are adhering to all school rules and regulations.
- Supervise children in classrooms, gymnasiums and outdoors as weather permits.
- Sign children out for pick up only to people authorized by their parents or guardians.
- Clean up the Aftercare room at the end of the day.

Requirements:

- Able to work Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday from 2:30 p.m. 6:00 p.m.
- Must successfully pass the required background check and all requirements of the Diocesan Program for Child and Youth Protection prior to employment and maintain a satisfactory background check throughout employment.
- The ability to respect, promote, accommodate, and not be in conflict with the mission, moral and social teachings, doctrines, and laws of the Roman Catholic faith.
- Able to work Monday and Tuesday from 2:30 pm 6:00 p.m. from time to time.
- Able to work past 6:00 p.m. on rare occasions.
