Purpose: The Dress code is a common-sense guideline for uniformity to prevent jealousy, envy or greed. Vanity can often lead to arrogance and judgment of others; We are called upon not to think too highly of ourselves, and not to judge others. The Dress Code is a tool to help you, as parents, to prevent arguments over the latest fashion trends, styles, and demands for "things". Dress Code violations will be tracked and affect a student's conduct grade and may require further disciplinary action. Habitual dress code violations may result in detentions or in some cases, suspension.

Pants

- Solid navy blue or khaki dress pants (all grades)
- No cargo pockets, skin tight, or spandex
- Solid black or brown belt only – students must wear a belt

Shorts/ Skirts/ Jumpers

- Shorts worn only in August, September, or May
- No cargo shorts
- Solid navy blue or khaki
- Skirts and jumpers must be Schoolbelles brand – only blue/gold plaid can be worn starting Fall of 2021
- No shorter than 2 inches above knee

Shirts

- Solid navy blue or pastel yellow **with collar.** (No white, black, light blue, or other shades of yellow/gold)
- Must be appropriate size, length, and all shirts must be tucked in.
- No form fitting/tight, low cut shirts

Sweaters/ Vests/ Fleece

- Solid white or navy blue are only acceptable colors
- Cardigan, V-neck, or crew neck
- MBS fleece/ quarter zips are the only jackets allowed on in school (No NCCS fleece jackets are allowed)
- No hoodies, logos, or decals on sweaters/ sweatshirts
- House gear crew neck sweatshirts and jackets may be worn

Shoes

- Dress shoes should be solid brown, tan, black, navy blue, or classic saddle shoes
- **All black tennis shoes are permitted (logos, laces, and soles of shoe must be black)**
- Must have tennis shoes for gym class
- No sandals, boots, crocs, or slippers
- **Socks are to be white, black, or navy blue with no visible logos**

If a serious issue arises and a student is unable to comply with dress code regulations, the student may bring a note of explanation to the office signed by a parent/ guardian. A dress code permit will be issued to the student for one day only. Students not following the dress code will be subject to disciplinary actions. These policies will be strictly enforced. **The principal retains the right to make a judgment regarding questionable dress of a student and change the above code.**

Items not appropriate (not exclusive):

- Excessive: jewelry (this includes earrings for boys), hairstyles, make-up, etc. Girls are allowed one pair of earrings, no hoops.
- Bows, beads, and other hair accessories must be either white, black, or school colors.
- No purses can be worn – must be kept in locker
- No smartwatches are allowed
- Visible undergarments
- Tight-fitting clothing
- Nail polish other than clear, light pink, flesh tone, or white.
- No fake/acrylic nails are to be worn to school
- Hair is to be neat, clean, and well groomed, no colors in hair permitted, hair must be above the shoulders for boys
- Leggings, yoga pants, or jeggings are not allowed

Gym Uniforms

- Students in Grades 4-8 are required to change for gym
- Students must wear approved gym uniform sold in our Sprit Store offerings (Spring, Summer, Winter) OR
- Plain t-shirts, shorts, or sweatpants in school colors
- Students in all grades must have tennis shoes/sneakers for gym class
- Students who are not properly dressed for gym class with be made to sit out and their grade will be affected

Failure to Follow School Dress Code will result in the following (in no particular order)

- Detentions
- Loss of privileges such as recess or specials
- Suspension
- Parent will be required to bring appropriate clothing to school
- Student sent home
- Loss of dress down privileges for student for duration determined by administration
- Permanent removal from School
