#### <u>2024–2025 Dress Code</u>

## <u>Pants</u>

- Solid navy blue or khaki dress pants (all grades)
- No cargo pockets, skin tight, leggings, jeggings, or spandex
- Solid black or brown belt only (Grades 3-8) (K-2 do not need belts.)

## Shorts/ Skirts/ Jumpers

- Shorts worn only in August, September, or May
- No cargo shorts
- Skirts and jumpers may be the Schoolbelles plaid, solid navy blue or solid khaki
- No shorter than 2 inches above knee

#### <u>Shirts</u>

- Solid navy blue, white, or pastel yellow <u>with collar</u>
- Girls shirts may have the rounded collar
- Must be appropriate size, length, and remain tucked in
- No tight, form fitting, low cut shirts, or shirts that show the midriff

# <u>Gym Uniforms</u>

• ALL students MUST wear the required gym uniform and tennis shoes on gym days.

# Sweaters/Vests/Fleeces

- Solid white, gray, or navy blue
- Cardigan, V-neck, or crew neck
- <u>MBS</u> fleece from Schoolbelles or Greybot are the only fleece sweatshirts allowed in school
- No hoodies, logos, or decals on sweaters or fleeces

## Shoes and Socks

- Tennis shoes may be worn with all uniforms.
- Dress shoes are acceptable
- Socks MUST be worn and MUST fit over the ankle/shoe
- Multi-colored, fuzzy, pj socks are NOT permitted
- No sandals, flip-flops, boots, Crocs, or slippers

# Other Dress Code Items:

- Girls and Boys MAY wear one set of small earrings, one necklace, one ring, and one watch or bracelet on each wrist
- Hair must be neat and well groomed
- Hair Color (all), Make-up (6-8) and nail polish (all) must be light/natural colors. NO unnatural colors in the hair, including extensions, are allowed
- Undergarments MAY NOT be visible
- No nose or other facial piercings are permitted
- No visible tattoos are permitted

If a serious issue arises and a student is unable to comply with dress code regulations, the student may bring a note of explanation to the office signed by a parent/guardian. A dress code permit will be issued to the student for one day only. Students not following the dress code will be subject to disciplinary actions. These policies will be strictly enforced. The principal retains the right to make a judgment regarding questionable dress of a student and change the above code.
