****Just a reminder that there is NO AFTER CARE ON FRIDAYS DURING LENT because of the Fish Fry.**

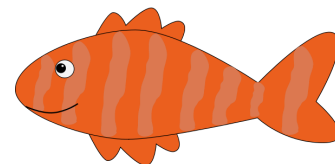
