Report Card/Progress Reports

Progress Reports are issued at the 4¹/₂ week period of each quarter for all students. Report cards are issued at nine week intervals. Records/report cards may be withheld if the parent owes tuition or fees. Quarterly Progress Reports will include the input from the main classroom Teacher–Minister and include comments, as well as indications of skill levels.

Student progress can be tracked by parents daily through Option C.
