

Report Card/Progress Reports

Progress Reports are issued at the 4½ week period of each quarter for all students. Report cards are issued at nine week intervals. Records/report cards may be withheld if the parent owes tuition or fees. Quarterly Progress Reports will include the input from the main classroom Teacher-Minister and include comments, as well as indications of skill levels.

Student progress can be tracked by parents daily through Option C.

Honor Roll Criteria

Students in grades 4-8 who earn high marks are eligible for the Honor Roll each quarter. Award celebrations are held at the end of each quarter.

School Honors are determined by the student's behavior, attitude, and conduct displayed in and out of the classroom. * Grade Point Average (GPA) will be calculated based on the scale listed on the report cards and only in grades 4-8 for scholarship purposes.
