There is a letter regarding tuition attached to this week's newsletter. Please read through it carefully and contact me if you have any questions.

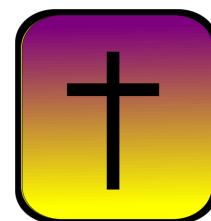
