Fr. Keith, Mr. Demagall, and the Most Blessed Sacrament Finance Council have met to discuss our school budget and tuition for the 2026-2027 school year. Due to rising operational costs, including increased expenses for teacher salaries, benefits, utilities, and instructional resources, our school will be implementing a tuition increase for the upcoming academic year. This decision was made with careful consideration and in consultation with our Finance Council to ensure we can continue to provide a high-quality, faith-centered education for our students. We remain committed to supporting our families and will continue to offer assistance where possible to ensure accessibility for all.

Tuition for the upcoming school year will be \$6,950 per student. We understand that this represents a significant commitment for our families, and we want to assure you that our school is dedicated to supporting you in any way we can. We remain committed to working with families to explore available assistance options and to ensure that a Catholic education remains accessible to all who seek it.

The following is a list of ways to help cover the difference between the \$6166.00 EdChoice Scholarship and the listed tuition.

Low Income Verification

Families that qualify as a family that receives free or reduced lunch through income verification do not pay the difference between the EdChoice scholarship and tuition.

Parish Financial Aid

By applying for this parents/guardians are indicating that they are active in the community of Most Blessed Sacrament Parish and School and are in need of financial support.

Diocesan SGO

Families can apply for a Diocesan Scholarship to help offset the difference between the EdChoice Scholarship and tuition balances that are owed.

Tuition invoices will be sent out in the month of July with directions on how to apply for financial aid, scholarships, and make payments.
